Use correct and proper language at all times.

Members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs on club premises or whilst representing the club.

Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions

Members must wear suitable kit for training as agreed with the coach/team manager.

Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.

Bullying of any sort will not be tolerated

Members are expected to alert coaches/officials of anything that may cause danger to other members
